

# CURRICULUM OVERVIEW AUTUMN TERM 1 YEAR 1

This half term Woodpeckers will be learning all about Into The Woods

#### **ENGLISH**

We will be reading texts linking to 'Into the Woods.'. We will explore traditional tales with predicting phrases which we can join in with. We will be writing our own stories and letters to the characters.

#### MATHS

We will be securing our knowledge of place value. We will count forwards and backwards and find one more and one less. We will also find and prove the number bonds to ten. We will begin counting in 2s and 5s.

#### SCIENCE

The topic for this term is 'All About Humans'. We will be learning about our 5 senses and what they help us do. We will be conducting some simple experiments to test our senses. We will also be learning about Autumn and how the season has changed.

#### HUMANITIES

In **GEOGRAPHY** we are looking at our local environment. We will be learning the difference between physical and human geography. This term in **RE** we will be exploring being inspired. We will be reading stories from Christianity to support our learning about Jesus.

# PSHE

We will be learning about Being Me In My World. We will learn about our responsibilities in the class.

#### MUSIC

We will be exploring the style of rap music in the topic titled 'Hey you!'. We will be learning about beats and rhythms.

#### COMPUTING

During this topic we will be learning how to programme moveable toys using simple codes.

#### PF

We have two PE lessons a week, Monday and Tuesday. Our PE topics for this term are Fundamental Skills and Fitness.

In Fundamental skills, we will be recapping some of the basic skills learnt in EYFS and building upon these. In our fitness topic, we will be learning about different ways to stay healthy at home and at school.


#### **ART**


We will explore self-portraits and create our own by mixing colours to make our skin tones and hair colours. We will practice our sketching pencil grip.
