Our New Reward System

We are writing to update you about our reward systems in school and the badges your children can earn moving forward.

With the change in the school logo, we decided as staff, that we would offer the children different coloured star pin badges for each stage they achieve, this means they can be transferred from jumper to jumper.

For this year, all children will start at the beginning of the colours for their year group, to get it established and then after that as your child moves up the school, they will be working towards the next badge they are on.

In Reception the children will start from the blue badge this year, Year 1 from the yellow badge and Year 2 from the bronze badge

Please see below for how it works and the progression.

In EYFS for every 5 effort stars, they will receive 1 effort mark in their passport, for every 10 effort marks they will receive a badge.

In KS1 for every 10 effort stars, they will receive 1 effort mark in their passport, for every 10 effort marks they will receive a badge.

1st effort badge – Blue 2nd effort badge – Red 3rd effort badge – Green 4th effort badge – Yellow 5th effort badge – Orange 6th effort badge – Purple 7th effort badge – Bronze 8th effort badge – Silver 9th effort badge – Gold

If pupils achieve all their effort badges, they will then be working towards the gold cup!
