Curriculum

The aim of the curriculum at Shepherdswell Academy is to provide an ambitious, motivating and enriched curriculum that meets the needs of all children, allowing them to explore and understand the world they live in.

Our curriculum incorporates the key knowledge, skills and understanding sset out in the National Curriculum and other experiences and opportunities which best meet the learning and development needs of the children in our school, equipping them with high levels of literacy, numeracy and critical and creative thinking skills essential for now and in the future.

The curriculum is carefully planned with high expectations to ensure clear progression within all curriculum subjects and aims to support children in gaining a deeper understanding of their learning. Our children are provided with a firm grounding in core skills including, reading, writing, spelling, grammar and mathematics.

We understand the importance of enrichment opportunities, and plan for a variety of events including Forest Schools, after school clubs, visitors and visits.

Pupil Welfare

Shepherdswell Academy are committed to delivering good outcomes for children by providing a safe learning environment that promotes their welfare and helps them to develop socially and emotionally so that they can make the most of their life chances.
