AUTUMN TERM 1 EYFS

This half term Hedgehogs and Squirrels will be learning all about Our Community!

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be learning about the different roles of people in our community who help us. We will hopefully meet some of them and think of questions to ask them. We will be talking lots about what we can see.

LITERACY

We will be reading stories and non-fiction books about the different roles of people in our community. We will continue to work on sounding out and writing short words.

MATHS

This term we will be focusing on naming and identifying a range of 3D and 2D shapes. We will be thinking about numbers up to 5 and how to add and partition within this number.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be continuing to think about how to be a kind friend, but also how to be a good member of our community. We will be learning about our school values and how we can show we are ready, respectful, and safe.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will be learning about lots of celebrations such as Diwali, Hannukah, Bonfire Night, and Christmas. We will learn about some of the different people who celebrate these festivals. We will be learning about the roles of people who help us, and what these jobs might have looked like in the past. We will be looking at pictures of things in our community and talking about their features.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

We will be continuing to explore paint in different ways. We will be using a variety of tools to make different marks and experimenting with different ways of making representations. We will start practicing singing a range of songs for our special performance at the end of term.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will continue to focus on holding our pencil properly, and forming letters correctly. We will travel and move around in a variety of ways to help our gross motor skills.

MUSIC

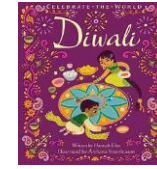
During this topic we will be learning some songs for our performance and talking about our preferences.

Please complete one activity from each of the learning columns below: One topic, one Literacy and one Maths, so in total you will have completed 3 different pieces of home learning.

LITERACY

- Can you practise writing your name using a capital letter for the first letter of your name and lower-case letters for the other letters in your name?
- Can you tell an adult your favourite part of 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea?' They can write down what you say and you can draw a picture.
- Can you practice your new phonics sounds? Can you say all of them very quickly?

MATHS

- Go on a shape hunt around your house. What shapes can you find? Ms Whitehead has a clock shaped like a circle in her house. Miss Weatherspoon has a fridge shaped like a rectangle. You can take pictures or draw the things you find!
- Can you sing the song '5 Little Ducks Went Swimming One Day'? You can watch a video on YouTube or sing it by yourself. Can you show the number of ducks on your fingers?
- Can you practise counting lots of different objects to 3 e.g. cars, pasta, lego, teddies? What other objects can you find and count to 3?

TOPIC

 - What festivals do you celebrate with your family? Do you celebrate Christmas? Or Hannukah? Or Eid? Draw a picture of your family having fun!
- **PSED**
 - Who are the people in our community who help us? Can you think of a job they might do?
