SPRING TERM 1 EYFS

This half term Hedgehogs will be learning all people who help us in our community

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be learning about what happens in our community and the different jobs people do. We will be having lots of visitors and thinking about the questions we can ask them to help us understand something further.

LITERACY

We will be reading stories and non-fiction books that help us gain knowledge about the different people who help us in our community. We will be focusing on be able to write words independently and put them into a sentence.

MATHS

This term we will be focusing on counting to 10 and beyond. We will be learning about numbers that go together to make 5 - number bonds. We will be adding and subtracting numbers to 10.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will carry on our Calm Me Time, which helps us calm down when we are feeling big emotions. We will be thinking about our dreams and goals. We will be continuing our learning about sharing and taking turns.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will be learning lots of new information about people who help us. There will be lots of learning opportunities as people from our community come to school to teach us about the job they do. We will be having visits from the police, nurse and firefighters, we will even be walking to the café for a hot chocolate and a story.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

This half term we are learning about abstract artists such as Kandinsky, Kusama, Pollock, and Mondrian.

We will be experimenting with different media and materials to make our own artwork inspired by these artists. We will be thinking carefully and talking about why we chose to do things in certain ways.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

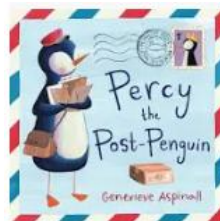
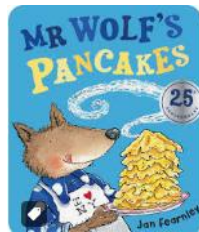

MUSIC

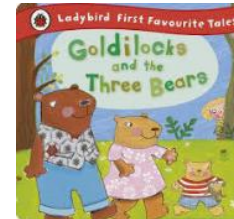
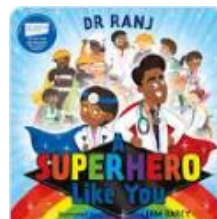
During this topic we will be learning some animal songs, and will perform them with a variety of instruments.
