COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

. We will be practicing talking in full sentences, and being able to answer questions as a character from the stories. We will be looking at different tenses - past present and future and talking about events which happen.

LITERACY

We will be reading traditional tales such as the Three little pigs and Goldilocks and the three bears. We will also be having a look at some non-fiction books and what the differences between these are.

MATHS

This term we will be focusing on counting beyond 5. We will be learning about numbers that go together to make 5 - number bonds. We will be adding and subtracting numbers to 10.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will carry on doing calm me time, this help us to be able to regulate our emotions and make the right choices. We will be thinking about our dreams and goals and what we would like to achieve by the end of seception.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

This half term we will be learning about Chinese new year, Eid and Shrove Tuesday. We will also being have a look at our surrounding and noticing changes in our environment due to the changes of seasons. We will bring some nature in from the outdoor environment to make some observational drawings.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

This half term we are learning about abstract artists such as Kandinsky, Kusama, Pollock, and Mondrian.

We will be experimenting with different media and materials to make our own artwork inspired by these artists. We will be thinking carefully and talking about why we chose to do things in certain ways.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be looking at different types of food and deciding if they are healthy, as well as learning other ways to keep our bodies healthy such as getting enough sleep and exercise, and making sure we brush our teeth!

MUSIC


We will be exploring their voices. They will be looking at the pitch and beat and practicing active listening.


Please complete one activity from each of the learning columns below: One topic, one Literacy and one Maths, so in total you will have completed 3 different pieces of home learning.
