COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be meeting lots of different people from our community where we will have the opportunity to ask lots of questions to widen our knowledge so we will be practicing speaking in full sentences.

LITERACY

We will be reading stories and non-fiction books that help us gain knowledge about the people who help us in the community. We will be thinking about the different between fiction and non fiction.

MATHS

This term we will be focusing on counting beyond 5. We will be learning about numbers that go together to make 5 - number bonds. We will be adding and subtracting numbers to 10.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will carry on our Calm Me Time, which helps us calm down when we are feeling big emotions. We will be thinking about our dreams and goals. We will be continuing our learning about sharing and taking turns.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will be learning lots of new information about the people who help us in the community. We will be having some special visitors in who have these different jobs so we are able to meet them and ask them questions to further develop our understanding. We will also be vets in the role play area to look after the sick animals.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

This half term we are learning about abstract artists such as Kandinsky, Kusama, Pollock, and Mondrian.

We will be experimenting with different media and materials to make our own artwork inspired by these artists. We will be thinking carefully and talking about why we chose to do things in certain ways.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be looking at different types of food and deciding if they are healthy, as well as learning other ways to keep our bodies healthy such as getting enough sleep and exercise, and making sure we brush our teeth!

MUSIC

During this topic we will be learning some animal songs, and will perform them with a variety of instruments.




Please complete one activity from each of the learning columns below: One topic, one Literacy and one Maths, so in total you will have completed a minimum 3 different pieces of home learning.
