



CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

SUMMER TERM 2 EYFS

This half term Hedgehogs will be learning all about our wonderful world and sustainability.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will continue our learning to ensure we are confident to be able to speak in full sentences. We will be learning some facts about different rainforest/jungle creatures and explain why we think it is important to protect the planet.

LITERACY

In Literacy we will be reading non-fiction texts about ocean animals and the amazon rainforest. In our writing we will be trying hard to remember our spaces between words, capital letters and full stops. We will be writing independently.

MATHS

This term we will be continuing our learning about addition and subtraction, as well as doubling numbers. We will be revisiting our learning of number bonds to 10 and seeing if we can recall them quickly. We will be counting forwards and backwards to 20, and looking at teen numbers to see if we can recognise them. We will also be looking at halving numbers

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Our Jigsaw piece this half term is called 'Changing Me'. We will be looking back at our year together and forward to next year, and talking about all the ways we have changed. We will also think about what will be different and the same next year!

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will be learning about different habitats and why it is important to look after them and protect them. We will learn about plastic pollution in the ocean, deforestation in the Amazon jungle, and about how to take care of the environment that we live in. We will also look back on the things that we have learned this year, and talk about things that happened in our past.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

This half term we will be looking at using materials to create our own pieces of art work. We will be using our knowledge of 3D shapes to make amazing creations from junk which also helps reduce, reuse, recycle.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

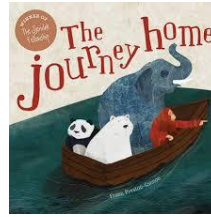
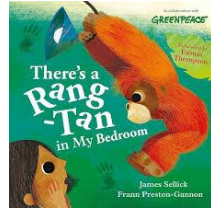

MUSIC

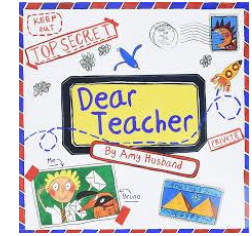
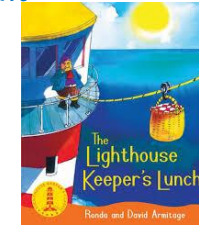
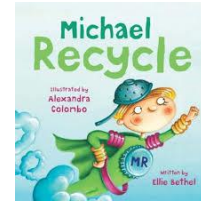
During this topic we will be learning some songs from around the world and performing these using some instruments.

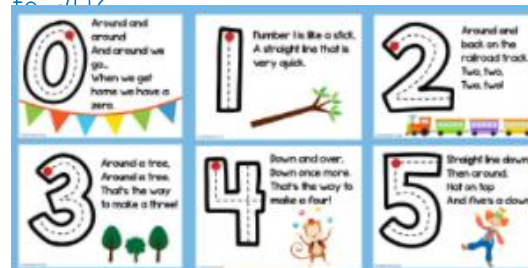

LITERACY

- Can you practise reading and writing words and/or sentences containing our newly learnt sounds? You could keep a diary, write a letter to a friend, or a letter to your teacher that you will have in September. Or a letter to Miss Weatherspoon and Miss Thompson about your memories of being a Hedgehog?
- Can you write about your favourite memories from your year being a Hedgehog? We had the farm visit us, made pancakes, made pumpkin soup, played with the bikes. We have had so much fun this year! What was your favourite memory?

MATHS

- Can you write down all your double facts to 10? E.g $5+5=10$, double 2 is 4 etc.
- Can you do some halving?
- Complete addition and subtraction number sentences to 10. E.g $6-2=4$ or $4+4=8$
- Can you write down your odd and even numbers?
- Can you practise writing your numbers to 20?
