ENGLISH

We will be reading texts linking to 'Into the Woods.'. We will explore Traditional tale with predicting phrases which we can all join in with. After we will introduce Season Poetry and discuss our likes and dislikes of the texts,

MATHS

We will be learning about the numbers up to 10, practising counting in 2's as well as recognising and writing the numbers. We will also be thinking about different ways of representing them.

SCIENCE

The topic for this term is our bodies. We will look at our senses and think about how we use them and the parts of the body they are linked to.

HUMANITIES

In HISTORY we will be learning about our own history, we will also be looking at our local area. This term in RE we will be exploring being inspired. We will be reading stories from Christianity to support our learning about Jesus.

PSHE

We will be learning about **Being Me In My World**. We will learn about our responsibilities in the class.

MUSIC

ART


We will explore self-portraits and create our own using different mediums including, photography, drawing, painting and printing.
