AUTUMN TERM 2 EYFS

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be thinking about how we can ask questions to be able to find out more information about something we are interested in. We will be practicing making our sentence longer using "and" and "because".

LITERACY

We will be reading stories and non-fiction books about different celebrations. We will be learning about Christmas, Eid, Remembrance day, Diwali and Hannukah and more.

MATHS

This term we will be focusing on learning to subitise numbers to 5, order numbers to 10, we will also be thinking about number bonds to 5 and how we can use a 5 frame to help us with this.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be continuing to think about how to be a kind friend, but also how to be a good member of our community. We will be learning about our school values and how we can show we are ready, respectful, and safe.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will be learning about lots of celebrations such as Diwali, Hannukah, Bonfire Night, and Christmas. We will learn about some of the different people who celebrate these festivals. We will be learning about the roles of people who help us, and what these jobs might have looked like in the past. We will be looking at pictures of things in our community and talking about their features.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

We will be continuing to explore paint in different ways. We will be using a variety of tools to make different marks and experimenting with different ways of making representations. We will start practicing singing a range of songs for our special performance at the end of term.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

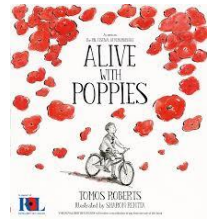
We will continue to focus on holding our pencil properly, and forming letters correctly. We will travel and move around in a variety of ways to help our gross motor skills.

MUSIC

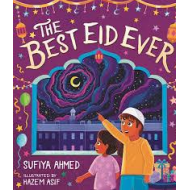
During this topic we will be learning some songs for our performance and talking about our preferences.

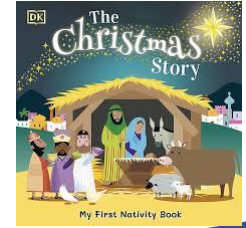

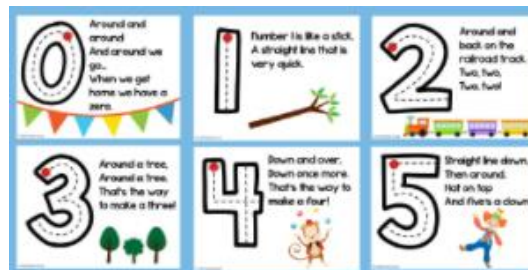
Please complete at least one activity from each of the learning columns below: One topic, one Literacy and one Maths, so in total you will have completed a minimum of 3 different pieces of home learning.

LITERACY

- Can you practice your new phonics sounds? Can you say all of them very quickly? Can you write some short words? Jam, pan, mat, cat, dog

MATHS

- Can you count to 10 and order your numbers correctly to 10.
- Can you think of different ways to make 5? Can you use a 5 frame to help you?
- Can you practise writing your numbers?
- Can you do a shape walk outside? What shapes can you see?
- Can you make a pattern? What comes next?
